A JOURNEY THROUGH 1 PETER

Begin: take this time to hear how everyone is doing, and get settled in.

- What is something to celebrate this week?
- IceBreaker: Share a moment when something difficult caught you totally off guard.  
How did you respond?

Listen: This is for reflection on Sunday's Sermon and thoughts from the message.

- What stood out to you about this week's message?
- Is there anything you are still thinking about or have questions about?

Discover: Take time to dig deeper into the passage/topic for this week.

- Read: 1 Peter 4:12-19
- Why does Peter tell believers not to be surprised at "fiery trials" (v. 12)?
- How does he connect suffering with sharing in Christ's glory (v. 13)?
- What does Peter say about suffering as a Christian in verse 16?
- How does judgment beginning with God's household (v. 17) fit into the passage?
- What final instruction does Peter give believers in verse 19?

Apply: Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your life.

- What trials are you currently facing, and how can you entrust them to God more fully?
- Where might God be inviting you to rejoice even in hardship?
- How can you stand firm when you feel misunderstood or mistreated for your faith?
- What does obedience look like for you in the middle of your current struggles?
- Who in your life needs encouragement to remain faithful during trials?
