Begin: take this time to hear how everyone is doing, and get settled in.

- What is something to celebrate this week?
- IceBreaker: How might Christians feel under attack today?
 - How are we limited or even punished in this attack?

Listen: This is for reflection on Sunday's Sermon and thoughts from the message.

- What stood out to you about this week's message?
- Is there anything you are still thinking about or have questions about?

Discover: Take time to dig deeper into the passage/topic for this week.

- Read: Daniel 6
 - Why did all the administrators and satraps conspire against Daniel?
 - How did the law target Daniel?
 - What do you notice about Daniel's response when he heard about the decree?
 - What comparisons can you draw from Daniel in the Lion's Den and Daniel 3 in the Fiery Furnace?
 - What then happens to Daniel's accusers and their families?

Apply: Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your life.

- How might living a faithful life for God draw opposition today?
- What does this chapter teach us about courage and faithfulness in the face of pressure to compromise?
- What opportunities do we have to point others to God's power through our own testimony of faith?
- This week, how might you remain faithful to God in prayer, obedience, or witness, even if it's unpopular or costly?
- MY ONE THING — What is your 1 takeaway from this study, and how will it impact your upcoming week?
