 - Who suggested calling Daniel, and why?
 - \bullet What was the meaning of the words "MENE, MENE, TEKEL, PARSIN"?
 - What is the difference between Belshazzar's response to God and Nebuchadnezzar's?

Apply: Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your life.

- As the king couldn't understand the writing without God's servant, how are you dependent on God's Word and the Holy Spirit as you navigate the unknown?
- "TEKEL" means "you have been weighed and found wanting." How does this challenge us to examine our lives in light of God's standards and not our own?
- How should the reality of life's uncertainty affect the way we live, plan, and honor God each day?
- This week, how can you honor God with greater reverence in your words, choices, or use of His blessings?
