- What is something to celebrate this week?
  - IceBreaker: Who is someone you consider truly faithful — and what makes them trustworthy?
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Listen: This is for reflection on Sunday's Sermon and thoughts from the message.

- What stood out to you about this week's message?
  - Is there anything you are still thinking about or have questions about?
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Discover: Take time to dig deeper into the passage/topic for this week.

• **Read: Hebrews 3:1-6**

- What are believers called to do in verse 1?
- How is Jesus compared to Moses in this passage?
- What does it mean that Jesus is "worthy of more glory" than Moses?
- What imagery is used about a house, and what does it represent?
- What condition is given in verse 6 regarding being part of God's house?

Apply: Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your life.

- What helps you “fix your thoughts on Jesus” in a distracted world?
  - Where are you tempted to place your trust in human leaders instead of Christ?
  - What does faithfulness look like in your current season of life?
  - How do you respond when your confidence begins to waver?
  - What practical steps can you take this week to hold firmly to your hope?
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- MY ONE THING — What is your 1 takeaway from this study, and how will it impact your upcoming week?
