IN A HOSTILE WORLD •

Begin: take this time to hear how everyone is doing, and get settled in.

- What is something to celebrate this week?
- IceBreaker: Tell of a time you've faced or seen a seemingly impossible situation.
 - What's the difference between "Seemingly impossible" and "Impossible"?

Listen: This is for reflection on Sunday's Sermon and thoughts from the message.

- What stood out to you about this week's message?
- Is there anything you are still thinking about or have questions about?

Discover: Take time to dig deeper into the passage/topic for this week.

- Read: Daniel 2
 - What does Daniel's response reveal about his faith and character? Did Daniel doubt God? Explain.
 - How does Daniel rely on prayer as a response to a difficult situation?
 - Do you tend to rely on God or ignore him and deal with the sin yourself? (Explain your reasoning)
 - In what ways does Daniel represent Christ in this passage?

Apply: Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your life.

- What does it look like for us to praise God both privately and publicly?
- Why does God sometimes put his servants in places of high authority? What privileges come with such positions? What dangers?
- How can our response to difficult situations give insight into our faith and character?
- How can you use your specific gifts to point back to God as a giver?
- MY ONE THING — What is your 1 takeaway from this study, and how will it impact your upcoming week?

Pray: Feel free to pray in a way that best fits your group. Take time each week to pray with and for each other.
