IN A HOSTILE WORLD •

Begin: take this time to hear how everyone is doing, and get settled in.

- What is something to celebrate this week?
- IceBreaker: “Pride comes before the fall.” How have seen this to be true.
- Why is Pride hard for us to recognize in ourselves?

Listen: This is for reflection on Sunday’s Sermon and thoughts from the message.

- What stood out to you about this week’s message?
- Is there anything you are still thinking about or have questions about?

Discover: Take time to dig deeper into the passage/topic for this week.

- Read: Daniel 4
 - What warning and counsel did Daniel give the king?
 - What indications do we have in this text that Nebuchadnezzar’s worship is genuine?
 - What happened when Nebuchadnezzar boasted about his power and greatness?
 - How did his sanity and kingdom get restored?
 - What truths about God’s rule does Nebuchadnezzar declare at the end?

Apply: Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your life.

- Describe a time when God has troubled your heart to get your attention. How did you respond?
- God shows patience in giving Nebuchadnezzar twelve months before judgment came. How have you experienced God's patience in your life?
- In the end, Nebuchadnezzar praises and honors God. How can we build habits of giving glory to God in our daily lives rather than keeping it for ourselves?
- How will you practice humility this week in a way that points to God's greatness instead of your own?
- MY ONE THING — What is your 1 takeaway from this study, and how will it impact your upcoming week?

Pray: Feel free to pray in a way that best fits your group. Take time each week to pray with and for each other.
