MAKING SENSE OF THE BOOK OF LEVITICUS

- Why should we learn about festivals that we no longer celebrate?
- On what day did God arrange for Jesus to be crucified? What is the significance of that?
- What festival was celebrated on the day Jesus was resurrected? What would be the importance of that?

**Apply:** Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your life.

- What principles from Israel's celebration can you apply to your life?
- How should we live differently in light of God's revealed truth in Leviticus 23?
- Do you order your life and plan your days according to the truth of God's Word?
- What truth did you learn through this study in Leviticus?
- How did this truth change the way you live?
