- Read: 1 John 4:1-6
 - Do you think false teachers are still a problem in the church? Why?
 - How can we properly identify them?
 - What is the significance of the statement, “Spiritual or religious activity is not necessarily godly activity.” How are they similar/different?
 - How can we identify false ideas of Jesus? What are some that are prevalent in our world today? What about in the Church?
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Apply: Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your own life

- When is it appropriate to call out false teachers?
 - How can we be diligent in protecting the church from false teachers?
- “Christians can be better known for what they are against than what they are for.”
 - What is the danger of only looking for the bad but missing the good?
 - What good in the church do you see?
