A JOURNEY THROUGH 1 PETER

Begin: take this time to hear how everyone is doing, and get settled in.

- What is something to celebrate this week?
- IceBreaker: Have you ever joined a group, team, or community that gave you a new sense of purpose or identity? What changed for you?

Listen: This is for reflection on Sunday's Sermon and thoughts from the message.

- What stood out to you about this week's message?
- Is there anything you are still thinking about or have questions about?

Discover: Take time to dig deeper into the passage/topic for this week.

- Read: 1 Peter 2:1-12
  - Why does Peter begin with putting away sinful attitudes (v. 1)?
  - What does it mean to crave pure spiritual milk (v. 2)?
  - How does Peter describe believers as "living stones" and a "holy priesthood" (vv. 4-5)?
  - What significant identity does Peter assign to God's people in verse 9?
  - What mission is given to believers in verses 11-12 as they live among unbelievers?

Apply: Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your life.
