



Begin: take this time to hear how everyone is doing, and get settled in.

- What is something to celebrate this week?
- IceBreaker: Have you ever spent a long time trying to fix a problem yourself, only to realize you needed someone else to do what you couldn't?

Listen: This is for reflection on Sunday's Sermon and thoughts from the message.

- What stood out to you about this week's message?
- Is there anything you are still thinking about or have questions about?

Discover: Take time to dig deeper into the passage/topic for this week.

• **Read: Hebrews 9:1-14**

- Verses 1–10 describe the layout of the tabernacle and its worship. What do these details teach us about people's access to God under the old covenant?
- According to verses 6–10, what limitations did the sacrifices and ministry of the earthly priests have?
- How does verses 11–12 describe Jesus' entrance into the heavenly sanctuary, and what makes His sacrifice different from those under the old covenant?
- Compare the cleansing described in verse 13 with the cleansing Christ provides in verse 14. What is the difference?
- According to verse 14, what was the purpose of Jesus' sacrifice beyond simply forgiving sin?

Apply: Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your life.

- Many people still try to earn God's approval through good works or religious activity. Why is that temptation so common?
- Verse 14 says Christ cleanses our consciences. What kinds of guilt, shame, or regret do people often continue carrying even after they've been forgiven?
- How does knowing Jesus' sacrifice was "once for all" change the way you view your relationship with God?
- Instead of serving God out of guilt or obligation, how can you serve Him out of gratitude for what Christ has already accomplished?
- What is one area of your life where you need to stop trusting in your own efforts and rest more fully in the finished work of Jesus?
- **MY ONE THING** — What is your 1 takeaway from this study, and how will it impact your upcoming week?

Pray: Feel free to pray in a way that best fits your group. Take time each week to pray with and for each other.
