



Begin: take this time to hear how everyone is doing, and get settled in.

- What is something to celebrate this week?
  - **IceBreaker:** Who is someone you really listen to when they speak—and what makes their voice carry weight for you?
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Listen: This is for reflection on Sunday's Sermon and thoughts from the message.

- What stood out to you about this week's message?
  - Is there anything you are still thinking about or have questions about?
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Discover: Take time to dig deeper into the passage/topic for this week.

• **Read: Hebrews 1:1-4**

- Vs 1-2 — How did God speak in the past vs. how He speaks now?
- What does the phrase "in these last days" suggest about the timing and significance of Jesus?
- List everything this passage says about who the Son is. (Vs 2-3)
- What does it mean that Jesus is the "exact imprint" of God's nature?
- What did Jesus accomplish according to verse 3, and what is His current position?

Apply: Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your life.

- What voices compete for authority in your life right now?
  - How does seeing Jesus as God's final and full Word change how you approach Scripture?
  - Where are you tempted to look for guidance outside of Christ?
  - What would it look like this week to intentionally "listen" to Jesus?
  - How does Jesus' finished work (purification of sins) affect your daily sense of identity?
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- MY ONE THING — What is your 1 takeaway from this study, and how will it impact your upcoming week?

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Pray: Feel free to pray in a way that best fits your group. Take time each week to pray with and for each other.

Notes: Space for your notes from your time together.
