



Begin: take this time to hear how everyone is doing, and get settled in.

- What is something to celebrate this week?
 - IceBreaker: Think of a moment when you expected bad news... but instead received incredibly good news. How did that shift your emotions?

Listen: This is for reflection on Sunday's Sermon and thoughts from the message.

- What stood out to you about this week's message?
 - Is there anything you are still thinking about or have questions about?

Discover: Take time to dig deeper into the passage/topic for this week.

- Read: Mark 16:1-8
 - In verses 1–3, what were the women expecting when they approached the tomb? What details show their assumptions?
 - Why is the question "Who will roll away the stone?" significant? What does it reveal about their understanding of the situation?
 - What message does the young man give in verses 6–7? List the key truths declared about Jesus.
 - Why is the phrase "just as He told you" important? What does it reveal about Jesus' authority and reliability?
 - Verse 8 says they fled trembling and astonished. Why do you think Mark ends the account this way? What emotions are present in the text?

Apply: Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your life.

- The women came prepared to anoint a dead body. Where in your life are you living as if Jesus is still in the tomb?
- What “stones” in your life feel immovable right now? How does the resurrection speak into those situations?
- The angel says, “He is not here.”
How does the resurrection change: Your view of death? Your fear? Your future?
- The women were afraid — yet commissioned to tell the disciples. What keeps you from sharing resurrection hope?
- If Jesus truly conquered sin and death, what bold step of obedience is He calling you to take?
- MY ONE THING — What is your 1 takeaway that will impact your upcoming week?

Pray: Feel free to pray in a way that best fits your group. Take time each week to pray with and for each other.
