



THE BOOK OF 1 Corinthians

Begin: take this time to hear how everyone is doing, and get settled in.

- What is something to celebrate this week?
- IceBreaker: When you have an important message to give someone, what form of communication do you use?
 - Does the form of communication change the importance of the message?

Listen: This is for reflection on Sunday's Sermon and thoughts from the message.

- What stood out to you about this week's message?
- Is there anything you still are thinking about or have questions about?

Discover: Take time to dig deeper into the passage/topic for this week.

- Read: 1 Corinthians 15:1-11
 - Why is the message of the gospel so vital and in fact of first importance?
 - With the gospel as a priority, what should that say practically to what is head in the church when the Word of God is preached every Sunday?
 - What is the gospel, and why are each of the three parts Paul mentioned so important to the whole?
 - What does the gospel have to say about the literal, physical resurrection of Jesus?

Apply: Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your life.

- What is it about the gospel that makes it so different from every other message that every other religion in the world has to offer?
- When is the last time you shared the gospel with an unbeliever?
- What did Paul mean in verse 3 when he spoke about holding to the message of the gospel?
- How might you be preparing yourself to share the gospel this week? Do you know who you might be sharing it with already?
- MY ONE THING — What is your 1 take-a-way from this study and How will it impact your upcoming week?
