



THE BOOK OF 1 Corinthians

Begin: take this time to hear how everyone is doing, and get settled in.

- What is something to celebrate this week?
- IceBreaker: What is the most generous act you have witnessed?
 - How has someone else's generosity impacted your own life?

Listen: This is for reflection on Sunday's Sermon and thoughts from the message.

- What stood out to you about this week's message?
- Is there anything you still are thinking about or have questions about?

Discover: Take time to dig deeper into the passage/topic for this week.

- Read: 1 Corinthians 16
 - Why is giving so important for the individual Christian?
 - Why is giving so important in corporate worship?
 - What should be the motivation behind all our giving?
 - Why should we give to causes and people who may never directly benefit our church?
 - Why is it important that the offering discussed was to be given and collected on the first day of the week?

Apply: Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your life.

- Do you believe the concept of tithing is still relevant today? Why or why not?
- How might we make sure that we give at least the first fruits of our own gifts to God?
- How might your own giving be a form of worship, and a help to the church's ministry?
