Begin: Take this time to hear how everyone is doing, and get settled.

- What is something to celebrate from this past week?
- IceBreaker: When you were a kid, what was one thing you looked forward to being able to do as an “adult”?
 - I doubt anyone mentioned jury duty, why would this not make the list?

Listen: Reflections on Sunday’s Sermon and thoughts from the message

- What stood out to you about this week's message?
- Is there anything you still are thinking about or have questions about?

Discover: Take time to dig deeper into the passage/topic for this week.

- Read: 1 John 5:6-12
- How does Jesus’ baptism reveal Him as the Son of God?
 - Why did Jesus need to be baptized?
- Why does John use the crucifixion as evidence in favor of Jesus divinity?
- Jesus said the Spirit would be coming to glorify Him. How does the Spirit still work to testify to Jesus?
 - Where should we expect to see the Spirit working?

Apply: Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your own life

- Think of someone you know who doesn't believe in Christ. What are the indications that the person wants more evidence?
 - What are the indications of a hard, rebellious heart?
- Why is personal testimony of conversion such a powerful witness to Jesus' deity?
- Why is a person's present testimony of Jesus' lordship just as important or more important than their remembering a past experience?
