



Begin: take this time to hear how everyone is doing, and get settled in.

- What is something to celebrate this week?
 - **IceBreaker:** Have you ever spent time fixing the same problem over and over again until someone finally solved it permanently? What was the difference between the temporary fix and the lasting solution?
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Listen: This is for reflection on Sunday's Sermon and thoughts from the message.

- What stood out to you about this week's message?
 - Is there anything you are still thinking about or have questions about?
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Discover: Take time to dig deeper into the passage/topic for this week.

• **Read: Hebrews 10:1-18**

- According to verses 1–4, why were the sacrifices under the Law unable to fully remove sin?
- In verses 5–10, what does the author teach about Jesus' willingness to do the Father's will, and why was that necessary?
- Compare the ministry of the Old Testament priests (v.11) with the ministry of Jesus (v.12). What differences stand out?
- What does verse 14 teach about Christ's sacrifice and its ongoing effect in the life of a believer?
- How do vs 15–18 connect Christ's sacrifice with God's promise of the new covenant?

Apply: Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your life.

- Why is it sometimes easier to believe God forgives others than to believe He has completely forgiven you?
- What are some ways people try to earn God's approval instead of resting in Christ's finished work?
- How does knowing that "there is no longer any offering for sin" (v.18) change the way you approach God?
- What is one area where you need to stop striving to earn God's acceptance and instead live out of the security you already have in Christ?
- **MY ONE THING** — What is your 1 takeaway from this study, and how will it impact your upcoming week?

Pray: Feel free to pray in a way that best fits your group. Take time each week to pray with and for each other.
