DISCOVERING THE FOUNDATION OF OUR FAITH

Begin: take this time to hear how everyone is doing, and get settled in.

- What is something to celebrate this week?
- **IceBreaker**: What is the award you are most proud of from High School or just from your school days?
 - How has this award impacted your adult life?

Listen: This is for reflection on Sunday's Sermon and thoughts from the message.

- What stood out to you about this week's message?
- Is there anything you still are thinking about or have questions about?

Discover: Take time to dig deeper into the passage/topic for this week.

- Read: Romans 3:1-20
- How does Paul prove that God could perfectly and fairly reject the Jew that does not repent? (Vs 3-8)
- How does what David says in Psalm 51 undermine false assurance? (Vs 4)
- How does this quotation from Psalm 14 (vs 10-12) back up what is said in vs 9?
- How do the quotes from Psalm 5, 140, 10 develop this idea more in vs 13-14?
- How do all these Scriptures make sure no one will be able to protest their innocence on Judgement Day? (Vs 19)?
- What does the Bible do, and what can it not do? (Vs 20)

Apply: Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your life.

- How can we as ‘Christian People’ try and persuade ourselves it would not be fair for God to be angry with us, even if we will not repent?
- Looking at these Old Testament quotations. Relate them honestly to our hearts, lips, and lives, as we are by nature.
- How do you need to take an honest look at your life, and allow and even as God for deeper conviction of sin?
- What things might you be doing as an attempt to save yourself?
- How can these hard truths, help you to grow in your relationship with God?
- **MY ONE THING** — What is your 1 take-a-way from this study and How will it impact your upcoming week?
