

# SET APART

A JOURNEY THROUGH 1 PETER

Begin: take this time to hear how everyone is doing, and get settled in.

- What is something to celebrate this week?
- IceBreaker: Think back to a time when you were chosen for something—a team, a role, a responsibility. How did it make you feel, & how did it change the way you behaved?

Listen: This is for reflection on Sunday's Sermon and thoughts from the message.

- What stood out to you about this week's message?
- Is there anything you are still thinking about or have questions about?

Discover: Take time to dig deeper into the passage/topic for this week.

- Read: 1 Peter 1:1-12
  - How does Peter describe the identity of believers in verses 1–2, and what does this reveal about God's initiative in salvation?
  - What does Peter say in verses 3–5 about the nature of the "living hope" believers have through Christ's resurrection?
  - In verses 6–7, what purpose does Peter give for the trials believers experience?
  - How do verses 8–9 describe the relationship between faith, love, and joy—even without seeing Christ physically?
  - What do verses 10–12 teach us about the prophets and angels concerning salvation and God's redemptive plan?

Apply: Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your life.

- If you truly embraced your identity as one chosen and known by God, how might that change the way you handle challenges this week?
- Where do you find yourself needing “living hope” right now, and how can you remind yourself of the inheritance that cannot perish or fade?
- How might your current trials look different if you viewed them as refining your faith instead of hindering it?
- In what areas of your life is it difficult to trust or love Christ “without seeing Him,” and what steps could help you grow in that unseen relationship?
- How does knowing that the prophets longed to see what you now know in Christ, shape your gratitude and your daily walk with Him?
- MY ONE THING — What is your 1 takeaway from this study, and how will it impact your upcoming week?

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Pray: Feel free to pray in a way that best fits your group. Take time each week to pray with and for each other.
