- Read: Romans 3:21-31
- What is Paul's main point in Romans 1:16-17? How is this echoed at the start of 3:21?
- How does Paul prove through the book of Romans so far, that there is nothing we can do to stop God being angry with us?
- Paul repeats the central theme of this paragraph a few times. What is the theme?
- What can the law not do?(3:20-21) What what does the Old Testament do? (3:21)
- Why is trust in Jesus the only way to be rescued?
- What does the death of Jesus achieve for us?
- What does the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross prove about God?

**Apply:** Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your life.

- Why is learning of God’s anger important to us?
- How do we often try to deal with God’s anger?
- How can surrender to Jesus help us in respect to God’s anger?
- How can it be a good thing that God is fair?
- How does reflection on the Cross, help lead us toward adoration, love and praise?
- How this week can you focus on the cross and grow in your love for God?
