



Begin: take this time to hear how everyone is doing, and get settled in.

- What is something to celebrate this week?
 - IceBreaker: Tell about a time when you had to trust someone even though you couldn't see how everything would work out. What helped you keep trusting?
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Listen: This is for reflection on Sunday's Sermon and thoughts from the message.

- What stood out to you about this week's message?
 - Is there anything you are still thinking about or have questions about?
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Discover: Take time to dig deeper into the passage/topic for this week.

• **Read: Hebrews 11:1-40**

- According to verses 1–3, how does the author describe faith, and what role does faith play in understanding God's work?
- As you read through the examples in this chapter, what common characteristics do you notice about the faith of Abel, Noah, Abraham, Moses, Rahab, and the others?
- Many of these people faced hardship, delay, or suffering. What does this teach us about the relationship between faith and difficult circumstances?
- Verses 13–16 say that many died without receiving everything that had been promised. How did they continue living faithfully despite that reality?
- According to verses 39–40, why were these faithful men and women still waiting, and what better promise had God planned through Christ?

Apply: Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your life.

- Where is God asking you to trust Him right now, even though you can't yet see the outcome?
- How do you usually respond when God seems to delay answering your prayers or fulfilling His promises?
- What habits help build enduring faith instead of temporary enthusiasm?
- If someone were writing a "Hebrews 11" story about your life, what step of faith do you hope would be included?
- MY ONE THING — What is your 1 takeaway from this study, and how will it impact your upcoming week?

Pray: Feel free to pray in a way that best fits your group. Take time each week to pray with and for each other.
