 - How did Daniel feel after seeing the vision, and what did he ask?
 - How does the vision end, and what does it reveal about God's kingdom?

Apply: Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your life.

- The beasts represent human kingdoms that rise and fall, but God's kingdom is eternal. How does this truth give us hope in a world where nations and leaders are constantly changing?
- How is God's sovereignty shown even over the beasts/kingdoms?
- What does it mean for us that Christ's kingdom will never be destroyed?
