



Begin: take this time to hear how everyone is doing, and get settled in.

- What is something to celebrate this week?
 - IceBreaker: Think about a time when something you thought was secure suddenly changed. What helped you find stability during that season?
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Listen: This is for reflection on Sunday's Sermon and thoughts from the message.

- What stood out to you about this week's message?
 - Is there anything you are still thinking about or have questions about?
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Discover: Take time to dig deeper into the passage/topic for this week.

• **Read: Hebrews 12:18-29**

- How does the author contrast Mount Sinai (v.18–21) with Mount Zion (v.22–24)? What does each mountain represent?
- According to verses 22–24, what blessings and privileges belong to those who come to God through Jesus?
- What warning is given in verses 25–27 about refusing God's voice, and what does the future "shaking" accomplish?
- What does the author mean by receiving "a kingdom that cannot be shaken" (v.28)?
- Why does the chapter end by reminding us that "our God is a consuming fire" (v.29)? What does that teach us about worship and our relationship with Him?

Apply: Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your life.

- What are some things people commonly build their security on that can ultimately be shaken?
- How does knowing you belong to God's unshakable kingdom change the way you face uncertainty or hardship?
- Verse 25 calls us to listen carefully to God's voice. What distractions or attitudes can keep us from hearing and obeying Him?
- How can gratitude shape the way you worship and serve God each day?
- What is one area of your life where God may be shaking your confidence in temporary things so that your trust grows deeper in Him?
- **MY ONE THING** — What is your 1 takeaway from this study, and how will it impact your upcoming week?

Pray: Feel free to pray in a way that best fits your group. Take time each week to pray with and for each other.
