DISCOVERING THE FOUNDATION OF OUR FAITH

Begin: take this time to hear how everyone is doing, and get settled in.

- What is something to celebrate this week?
- **IceBreaker**: Where have you found the best sense of community in your life?
- What difference does it make to have a sense of community within the church?

Listen: This is for reflection on Sunday's Sermon and thoughts from the message.

- What stood out to you about this week's message?
- Is there anything you still are thinking about or have questions about?

Discover: Take time to dig deeper into the passage/topic for this week.

- Read: Romans 4:1-15
- What did Abraham discover about boasting and getting right with God? (Vs 1-5)
- What did David say about being forgiven? (Vs 6-8)
- Why was Abraham justified by faith before he was circumcised? (Vs 9-12)
- What was the promise God made to Abraham and his offspring? (Vs 13)
- Why will this promise not be fulfilled by law? (Vs 14-15)

Apply: Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your life.

- Are there things in church we begin to worship rather than the God of all the earth?
- How can we remind each other in daily life of the truth of our imputed righteousness?
- What difference does justification by grace make to our prayer lives individually?
- How does that impact the church similarly or differently?
- **MY ONE THING** — What is your 1 take-a-way from this study and How will it impact your upcoming week?

Pray: Feel free to pray in a way that best fits your group. Take time each week to pray with and for each other.
