- Read: 1 John 4:7-21
 - How would you use these verses to explain to a child the meaning of "love"?
 - How is the supernatural love of God different from the superficial idea of love that we often hold onto?
 - How does John see a bloody cross as the highest expression of Love?
 - How is the life we live in Christ different from just religious rituals?
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Apply: Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your own life

 - How should the love shown by those born of God be different from what we see in our world?
- What is the difference between knowing God and knowing God personally as Savior and Lord?
 - Why is love a good test for whether someone knows God?
- How might you better display Christ love to those around you?
