Begin: Take this time to hear how everyone is doing, and get settled.



- What is something to celebrate from this past week?

- What was Jesus' purpose for the two peoples?

- What does the symbolism of circumcision represent?
- Read verses 14-16
- What does God mean when he says he destroyed the barrier or wall of hostility?

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- What does he mean by both in verse 18
 - What does it mean to be reconciled to others?
 - What is the relationship between a holy temple and your body?
 - What does it mean by “When you are being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit”?
 - How is Jesus your Cornerstone?
