



THE BOOK OF 1 Corinthians

Begin: take this time to hear how everyone is doing, and get settled in.

- What is something to celebrate this week?
- IceBreaker: What is the best gift that you have ever given?
 - What is the best gift you have ever received?

Listen: This is for reflection on Sunday's Sermon and thoughts from the message.

- What stood out to you about this week's message?
- Is there anything you still are thinking about or have questions about?

Discover: Take time to dig deeper into the passage/topic for this week.

- Read: 1 Corinthians 12:1-31
 - How must people depend on God as they use their spiritual gifts? Why is dependence on God crucial?
 - Have you ever been jealous of another person's spiritual gift?
 - Why is it significant that no one Christian has every spiritual gift?
 - Describe how spiritual gifts used properly will both express the diversity of the church and also bring unity to the church.
 - Why is it important to keep the idea of unity while talking about spiritual gifts?

Apply: Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your life.

- How can you cultivate joy in seeing others using their gifts?
- What role does Christian community play in helping people discern their spiritual gifts?
- How can your own gifts help bring unity to the church and also this group?
- How might you help others in identifying their gifts they might not yet see?
